

Let's Talk Dirty In Hawaiian - John Prine/Fred Koller

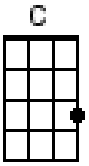
I [C] packed my bags and bought myself a ticket for the land of the tall palm [G]

[G] Would you like a [C] lei? [G] Eh?



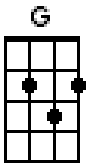
Chorus:

Let's talk dirty in Ha-[C]waiian say the [G] words I long to [C] hear



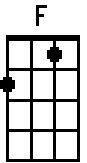
It's a [C] ukulele Honolulu sunset listen to the grass skirts [G] sway
