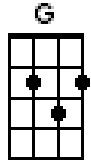


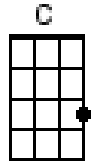
Jamaica Farewell – Written by Lord Burgess, Performed by Harry Belafonte

And when I **[D7]** reached Jamaica I **[G]** made a stop

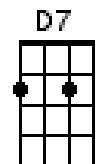
