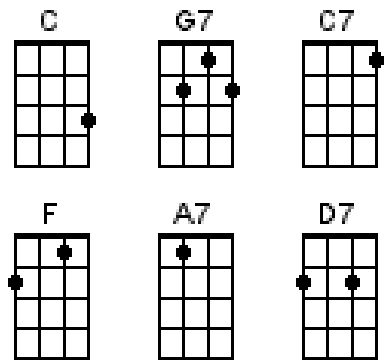


SNHUG Irish Medely – Traditional
